

## WHERE TO FIND REFEREE FEES

Referee fees are the responsibility of the individual teams and should be paid from your team account. We would suggest that you always print a copy of the referee fees to keep in your notebook in case you need to reference them on the field.

SCDSL – Our gaming league is Southern California Developmental Soccer League (SCDSL). Referee fees for league play can be found at [www.scdslsoccer.com](http://www.scdslsoccer.com). Scroll over “Resource Center” and click on “league documents” in the pull down menu. The current referee schedule is listed there. It will be updated every season. This schedule lists the total amount due for each game. Each team is responsible for one-half (1/2) of those fees and must be paid on the field, prior to each game in cash to the referees.

STATE CUP/NATIONAL CUP – Each year in the spring, our teams play either State or National Cup. Referee fees for this tournament can be found at [www.calsouth.com](http://www.calsouth.com). Scroll over tournaments and click on “State Tournaments” in the pull down menu. Click on the tournament your team will be attending (State Cup or National Cup). Click on the link “Referee fees”. Fees listed on this page are per team and identified by age group and division. Again the fees must be paid on the field prior to each game in cash to the referees.

ECNL/EGSL/ACADEMY – You can find the referee fee schedule for these leagues on their individual websites. For ECNL it is <http://www.eliteclubsnationalleague.com/>, EGSL is at <http://egsl.totalglobalsports.com/referee-fees/> and Academy can be found at <http://www.usoccer.com/Teams/Development-Academy/Academy.aspx>. Again, please note that the referees must be paid on the field prior to each game in cash.

CALIFORNIA REGIONAL LEAGUE (CRL) – The manager is generally notified of the referee fees prior to the season beginning in an email. They are also sometimes listed on the league front page as a document file. If you have not been notified prior to the first game, look to the website first, and then ask the appropriate contact indicating your team name and age group. The website is [www.californiaregionalleague.com](http://www.californiaregionalleague.com). Please pay the referees on the field prior to the beginning of the game in cash.

CLUB SPONSORED TOURNAMENTS – Referee fees are generally included in the registration fee for the tournament.
