Game Day?

Games will be 11:00am through 5:00pm

U4, U5 & U6

Each team is scheduled a 30min practice plus 45min game time each week.

(i.e. 11:00am to 12:15pm on field #1 At Oak Park High)

U7 & U8

Each team is scheduled a 30min practice plus 60min game time each week.

(i.e. 11:00am to 12:30pm on field #2 at Oak Park High)

Your team practice and play on the same day!

NO weeknight practice.

A - *NO sorry*

Q - Is it possible to have 1 more kid on my team?

A - *ONLY if ALL the parents understand that it will affect their kid's playing time.*

Q - *Is it coed*

A - *NO (But a girl can play on Boys team)*

U4 Teams play 4 Vs 4 (6 players) - Size 3 Ball, 7 min quarters. Eligible Birth Dates 08/01/06 thru 07/31/07

U5 Teams play 4 Vs 4 (6 players) - Size 3 Ball, 7 min quarters. Eligible Birth Dates 08/01/06 thru 07/31/07

U6 Teams play 4 Vs 4 (6 players) - Size 3 Ball, 7 min quarters. Eligible Birth Dates 08/01/05 thru 07/31/06

U7 Teams play 5 Vs 5 (7 players) - Size 3 Ball, 10 min quarters. Eligible Birth Dates 08/01/04 thru 07/31/05

U8 Teams play 6 Vs 6 (8 players) - Size 3 Ball, 10 min quarters. Eligible Birth Dates 08/01/03 thru 07/31/04
